Welcome to October! Looking at the forecast, it might be time to start pulling out the cooler weather attire. Is anyone else excited about rain and cooler temps in the forecast?!

We are now in the 5th week of the 1st quarter. Today, your child's Progress Report will be sent home in the Parent Envelope (Learning Center 3 and up). Please make sure you review your child's progress thus far.

Remember that to be eligible for the Honor Roll field trip at the end of the quarter, your student must be completing the required number of Paces per quarter (3 per subject if on-level, 4-6 per quarter if behind in any subject), have an average of 88 or above, and must have said their class scripture 7 out of the 9 weeks of the quarter. They must also not have repeated disciplinary issues.
